

ORDINANCE NO. 80

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE CRIME OF DISTURBING THE
PEARCE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Sibley, Louisiana, in regular session convened on 14th day of June, 1984, as follows:

SECTION 1.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen for the Village of Sibley, that Ordinance No. 80 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

"I. DISTURBING THE PEARCE

A. Disturbing the peace is the doing of any of the following in such a manner as would foreseeably disturb or alarm the public:

1. Engaging in a fistic encounter; or
2. Addressing any offensive, derisive or annoying words to any other person who is lawfully in any street or other public place; or call him by any offensive or derisive name or making a noise or exclamation in his presence and hearing with the intent to deride, offend or annoy him, or to prevent him from pursuing his lawful business, occupation or duties; or
3. Appearing in an intoxicating condition; or
4. Engaging in any act in a violent and tumultuous manner by any three (3) or more persons; or
5. Holding of an unlawful assembly; or
6. Interruption of any lawful assembly of people; or
7. Commission of any other act in such a manner as to unreasonably disturb or alarm the public.

B. Whoever commits the crime of disturbing the peace within the Village limits of the Village of Sibley shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict therewith are hereby repealed and amended.
