

ORDINANCE NO. 97-B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 86, 97 AND 97-A AUTHORIZING
THE IMPOSITION OF COURT COST FOR MAYOR'S COURT FOR THE
TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sibley, Louisiana in special session convened on July 15, 2002 as follows:

SECTION I.

IMPOSITION OF COURT COSTS FOR MAYOR'S COURT

The mayor or presiding court magistrate for Mayor's Court for the Town of Sibley be and he is hereby authorized to impose court costs not to exceed Thirty and No/100 (\$30.00) Dollars for each offense for any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance in mayor's court, the court costs to be allocated as follows:

Clerk's Fees not to exceed \$150.00 per month	\$5.00
General Fund & Police Dept. <u>Operating</u> Expenses	<u>25.00</u>


SECTION II.
