The Sibley Town Council met in regular session on Monday, September 18, 2023, at 6:00 PM in the Sibley Town Hall Meeting Room.

Members present were Mayor Jimmy Williams, Aldermen Robert Smart, Alan Myers, Wayne Bolton, Helen Chanler, and Richard Davis.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting with prayer and he led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Richard Davis motioned to adopt the minutes of the August 14, 2023, Regular Meeting, the August 25, 2023, Special Meeting, and the September 6, 2023, Special Meeting as read; Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried.

No new items were added to the agenda.

No public comments.

Robert Smart motioned to enter the Public Hearing on proposed Ordinance No. 153 titled AN ORDINANCE TO ENLARGE AND EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA, SO AS TO INCLUDE A TRACT LOCATED IN SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, WEBSTER PARISH, LOUISIANA, Wayne Bolton seconded. Motion carried.

Wayne Bolton motioned to close the Public Hearing and re-enter the Regular Meeting; Richard Davis seconded. Motion carried.

Robert Smart motioned to consider proposed Ordinance No. 153 titled AN ORDINANCE TO ENLARGE AND EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SIBLEY, LOUISIANA, SO AS TO INCLUDE A TRACT LOCATED IN SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, WEBSTER PARISH, LOUISIANA,

1. Ordinance 50-E titled AN ORDINANCE ADDING TO ORDINANCE 50-D PROVIDING FOR VICIOUS DOGS, DANGEROUS DOGS, AND DOGS AT LARGE WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SIBLEY AND TO DEFINE PENALTIES OF THE ABOVE-MENTIONED DOGS.

- 2. Ordinance No. 152-A titled AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN ROADWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF SIBLEY TO PROHIBIT THRU TRUCK TRAFFIC AND TO PROVIDE FOR A PENALTY IN VIOLATION THEREOF.
- 3. Ordinance No. 155 titled AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PROTECTED COVENANT FOR LANE MEADOWS SUBDIVISION.

Richard Davis motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2023-18 regarding a lease purchase agreement for the purpose of financing a tractor; Robert Smart seconded. Motion carried.

Robert Smart motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2023-19 regarding a lease purchase agreement for the purpose of financing a police patrol unit; Alan Myers seconded. Motion carried.

Richard Davis motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2023-20 setting the millage rate for the 2023 property taxes.

Helen Chanler seconded. Motion carried with the following vote:
